PLANTED-UP EGGSHELLS

Spring awakening in miniature format: the little plants in the eggshell look really sweet and are simply perfect to give to your loved ones.

METHOD

01. Eggs planted with succulents

Fill some cactus substrate into the eggshell. Take a small succulent and carefully press it into the substrate.

02. Eggs planted with cress

Place some cotton wool in the eggshell. Sprinkle with cress seeds and then moisten the seeds with water. Place the shell in a warm, bright place. After 2-3 days the cress will start to germinate.

03. Packaging

Carefully place the eggshells in an egg box. This makes a great way to present the eggs as a gift. In the egg-box lid you can also add a personal Easter greeting. If you choose the cress option, an Easter recipe with cress, of course, also makes a nice addition to the planted-up eggshell.

TIP

The succulents only need to be watered or lightly sprayed very occasionally.
